
GECRC is proud to have served 138 students in after-school programs in 2020-2021. Services provided to students and families included 1:1 tutoring for elementary students, group tutoring and 1:1 tutoring for junior high school students, academic enrichment, and outreach services that assisted with keeping students engaged in e-learning and supported families with school communications and resource referrals.

Nearly 200 volunteers assisted GECRC this school year, logging an impressive 3,737 service hours. A positive outcome from the shift to virtual tutoring was the accessibility of tutoring for many of our volunteers; some of which logged on

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

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




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#### **Summer School Kicks Off... In Person!**


