

Glen Ellyn Children's Resource Center (GECRC) is a non-profit afterschool and summer academic tutoring and mentorship program. Our mission is to help children from under-resourced families acquire the necessary academic skills to move successfully through grades K-12 and into adulthood. GECRC programs emphasize literary and community involvement, using the talents of teachers, volunteer tutors, and local support services. The after-school program supports more than 175 K-8 students annually at three District 41 school sites and two District 89 school sites, as well as hosting a six-week long GECRC Summer Program.

Core literacy services are supplemented through collaborations with community service providers to offer children a variety of enrichment and socio-emotional learning opportunities. GECRC strives to help parents and caregivers support their children's educational and social development.

#### MARY BETH KEANE

Mary Beth Keane's fourth novel, *The Half Moon*, was just released in paperback on April 2. Named one of the most anticipated books of 2023 by Vogue and Entertainment Weekly, *The Half Moon* 

is a compelling read that explores relationships, small town familiarity, and life changing choices, as told by a master storyteller.

Mary Beth attended Barnard College and the University of Virginia, where she received an MFA. She was awarded a John S. Guggenheim fellowship for fiction writing, and has received citations from the National Book Foundation, PEN America, and the Hemingway Society. She is the author of *The Walking People, Fever*, and *Ask Again, Yes*, which spent eight weeks on the *New York Times* Best Seller List. To date, *Ask Again, Yes* has been translated into twenty-two languages.




